Tough yet flexible. Maintained easily with highspeed burnishing, lower speed spray buffing, or EXCALIBER restorer. Will not yellow. Equally effective on resilient floors, Terrazzo floors, sealed concrete and wood surfaces.

Clean floor thoroughly with a good wax stripper. Rinse well and allow to dry completely. Apply EXCALIBER with a clean mop or a lambs wool applicator allow to dry for 30 minutes, then apply additional coats of finish if desired. Two or Three coats assure your most cost effective durability. Maintain by damp mopping with a neutral floor cleaner.
